Dear SEPO Board and Residents, I visited with Walgreens on 1810 W. Tyler recently. The COVID-19 vaccines are approved for Boosters.

The Walgreen's Pharmacy crew is willing to come to Sunshine and administer COVID-19 Vaccines & Boosters for us. They are offering other vaccine types too, such as Flu, Shingles, Pneumonia and Tetanus. There is a lot of easy access, competition and choices out there for you to get these shots (including Encore). So if you sign up for the commitment at Sunshine, please show up. You will be in Golf Carts to expedite the flow at Sunshine.

Plan: Line up at the Retzlaff Kitchen door, 2 x 2 (the vaccine staging will be obvious). Following your injection, drive over toward the Shuffleboard courts for observation for 15 or 20 minutes. Then off you go.....

If some volunteers wish to bring light refreshments – goodies etc. or have the Coffee on, go for it. Let me know.

You will also have other vaccine opportunities, if you wish, for: FLU (Influenza) Vaccine - Shingles Zoster Vaccine - Pneumococcal Vaccine

and/or TDAP – Tetanus, Diphtheria & Pertussis Vaccine. Please be aware that depending on the type of insurance coverage you have, you may have a copay for these additional shots.

Residents: Please, you are required to sign up on my sheet so we know who is coming and what quantity of Boosters etc. we need. Signup sheets will be posted in the Library – one is for the COVID-19 Booster, the other is for optional vaccines.

Name the Vaccines you need or want. I will have a fact sheet for each. Some folks may choose two vaccine choices COVID-19 & Flu for example, but most feel one at a time is enough. Check with the Pharmacist if you have questions.

I will need some Vaccine observers, Blood Pressure takers and a few others to help or relieve just in case.

And - Yogi Berra once said "It's ain't over 'til it's over" - the paperwork is what he was referring to.

(Bring your ID and Insurance Card and your COVID-19 card)
 Have it copied (zeroxed) for them or complete Section D

* Yes, I do have paperwork here for you: It is called a *Vaccine Administrative Record* – Section A thru G. You only have to focus on A B C D

SECTION A: Name, DOB, etc.

"I want to receive the following vaccinations":

Pfizer or Moderna (booster or shot 1 or 2), Flu, Shingles Pneumococcal, Tetanus etc.


SECTION B: (questions for all vaccines) ("Yes" "No" "Don't Know")
For COVID-19 = answer questions 1 thru 11
For Flu, Shingles etc. = answer questions 1 thru 16

SECTION C: Your signature & date

SECTION D: Insured Patient or authorized person to complete (That's why xeroxed copies are more efficient.)

After obtaining a headcount, for each vaccine, (Confirm with Walgreens if one or more for you is a good idea, if so inclined). Information and other papers will be included and available.
