### **Sunshine Resident Identification Sticker & Disc**

If you have changed cars or are new to our community and do not have a **Sunshine Smiley Face sticker** for your car, please contact either Valerie in the office or Jean Burgoine. These stickers are free.

If you need the four (4) inch plastic yellow disc that attaches to your golf bag, please contact Valerie in the office. The disc is free. It identifies you as a member of the community with full golfing privileges. This was the only way to identify legal golfers before the golf cart "use fee" sticker was instituted. You must purchase a "use fee" sticker yearly in order to ride on the cart paths in your golf cart while playing. We instituted the Sunshine Smiley Face car sticker also be used on golf carts during covid to identify you as a member of the community. Every golf cart should have either a valid golf cart path "use" sticker or a free Sunshine sticker (if you don't use your golf cart when playing golf). Every golf bag should have the four (4) inch yellow disc attached.
